



## New Zealand Credits

When researching courses in NZ remember that Semester 1 in the UK is Semester 2 in NZ and vice versa! Students in their second year at The University of Manchester should typically take Level 2/200 and 3/300 courses at New Zealand universities.

All guidance on credit load is based on a student replacing 60 University of Manchester credits per semester. Students will also need to be mindful of minimum credit requirements for full-time status for visa requirements.



### University of Auckland

#### Credit System/Standard Workload (and course catalogue links)

A normal full time load at the University of Auckland is 60 credits (each course carries 15 credits or points).

**Credit System/Standard Workload  
(and course catalogue links)**

A normal full time load at the University of Otago is 54-72 points per semester. Courses at Otago are called “papers”. Students will need to take 4 papers per semester.
